Rievaulx is a small pretty village nestled in the Rye valley of the North York Moors on the banks of the River Rye.

There has been a Christian presence in the village for hundreds of years since the time that the Cistercian monks built their spectacular monastery of Rievaulx Abbey. OUR LOVELY CHAPEL IS SITUATED AT THE TOP OF THE PICTURESQUE VILLAGE OF RIEVAULX, 2 MILES NORTH OF HELMSLEY, JUST OFF THE B1257 HELMSLEY TO STOKESLEY ROAD WHERE THE RIVER RYE FLOWS ON ITS WAY THROUGH THE VALLEY ALONGSIDE THE BEAUTIFUL RUINS OF RIEVAULX ABBEY.

Facilities available for use include the chapel, schoolroom, kitchen and toilets, loop system, projection screens, worship books etc. Disabled Access can also be provided.
